One of our biggest accomplishments was putting together a very successful Nickel Day 2022. This is one of our community's biggest events and it takes a lot of volunteers, hard work and sponsorship to make it happen. The businesses and volunteers in our community are some of the best, and we appreciate everything that they do for us. Go Waterville!!

Other activities that Waterville Community Connections have hosted include The Annual Easter Egg Hunt, The Case Race, the Annual July 3rd Activities, The 2nd Annual Autumn Flannel Fest, and Christmas on Commercial Street.
